Key Vocabulary

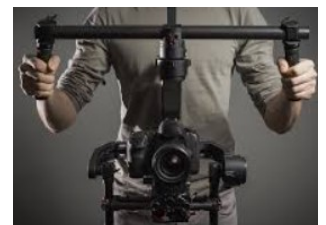
Tier 1: Video, audio, camera, lens, zoom, pan, share, edit, microphone, storyboard
