Legacy and Significance

Prior Knowledge:

Lesson 1: I can discuss and explain what I know about what Christians believe God is like.

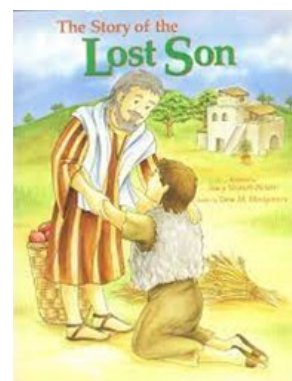
Lesson 2: I can know what happens in a church and recognise the importance of the Bible to Christians.

Lesson 3: I can understand the story of 'The Lost Son'.

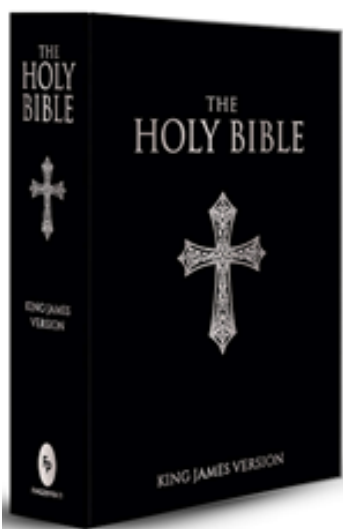
Lesson 4: I can know how Christians put their beliefs into practice through prayer.

What is the Bible and why is it important?

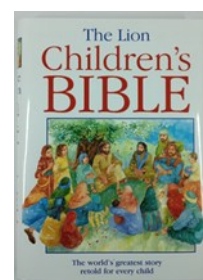


My Composite Knowledge:
