## Prior Knowledge

They then developed drawing and painting skills, studying Piet Mondrian and his use of primary colours and geometric shapes.

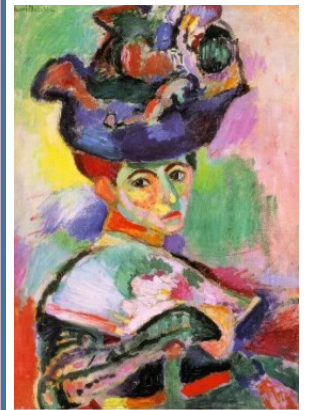
Lesson 6: I can evaluate our large collage inspired by Matisse.
