Dear Parents/Carers of \$SchoolMember\$

RE: Key Stage Two – Wake Park – Tuesday 10th June 2025

We have arranged a visit to the North Devon Wake Park near Bideford on Tuesday 10th June 2025 for all of Key Stage Two. This trip will give opportunities for all children and develop confidence of being in the water with various obstacles to attempt on the aquapark. The centre will provide buoyancy aids, wetsuits and helmets for all. Due to this activity being outdoor and including water an SOE3 form will have to be completed before your child can take part. We will travel via coach from school and back again, leaving school at 9:50am. To make the most out of the opportunity we will not be returning to school until 4pm meaning we will not be back in time for the usual school buses. Therefore, we politely ask that all children need to be collected from school on this day.

Cost:

- £5.00 per child to include the hire of the required safety equipment, transport to and from the venue and a session on the aquapark. We have been able to heavily subsidise this trip with school fundraising and some of our PE premium. Without this fundraising this trip would have cost £25 per child.

Children will need:

- to wear a swimming costume under some older clothes
- shoes that can get wet
- dry shoes and socks
- a dry change of clothes including underwear
- a towel
- sun cream
- a hat
- a waterproof coat
- a packed lunch and drink (no glass bottles, sweets or fizzy drinks). A school packed lunch can be requested on the gateway and where applicable a charge of £2.50 will be added to your child's account
- a small rucksack style bag to carry their belongings with a wet bag to carry wet items

Payment:

- A payment request has been set up on the gateway, please give your consent, payment and return a completed SOE3 form by Monday 2nd June 2025.

Please can we remind you that it is your responsibility to contact admin to cancel your child's meal, Early Birds or All Sorts bookings if they are on a trip and will not be in school for any of the above.
