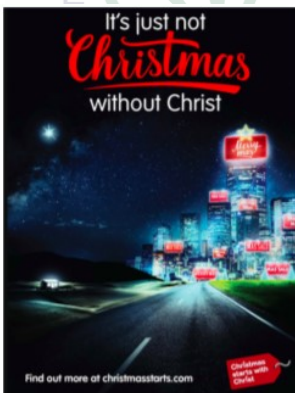

Lesson 3: I can gather evidence to see why Jewish people didn't and don't believe Jesus was the messiah.

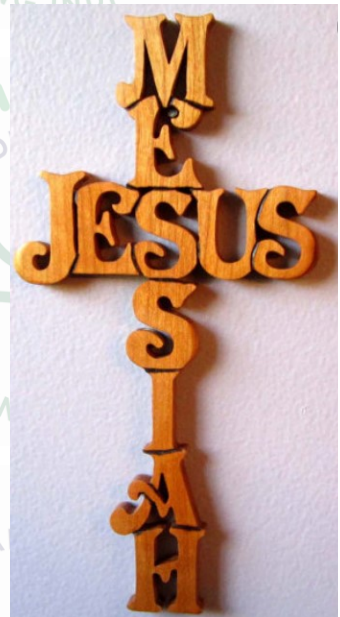
Lesson 4: I know the meaning of atonement.
