This week, as part of our phonics sessions we will be revising and reviewing words with two or more digraphs such as:

sharp, march, harsh, queen, torch, singer, corner

We will be focusing on looking for digraphs within words before we try and decode them. Please encourage your children to do the same at home asking them questions such as: 'where are the digraphs in this word?' 'how many digraphs are there?' 'what sound do the digraphs make?'

> We will also be practising the tricky words: **no, of, to, into, she, he, we**

We are slowly moving over to our new reading scheme books. Those children who are reading our new books will be bringing home different books to the ones we read in school as more than one group may be reading the same book and we do not have enough copies to send home unfortunately. We will however, be sending home books which are of a similar level which we encourage you to share with your children at home.
