This week, as part of our phonics sessions we will be revising and reviewing longer words such as:

**winking, waiting, wooden, marching,
garden**

We will be looking at how the 's' grapheme can make the /z/ sound within, and at the end of words such as:

visit, queens, poison

We will also be looking at how the suffixes '-s' and '-es' as the end of words can create plurals and the present tense of verbs:

torches, foxes, surfs, cooks

Finally, we will be practising the tricky words:

they, all, by, my, are, sure, pure

Please help your child to look out for these type of words in their reading books at home this week.
